Palm Sunday is sometimes called the "Triumphal Entry"

Matthew 21:1-11 (NLT)

1"As Jesus and the disciples approached Jerusalem, they came to the town of Bethphage on the Mount of Olives. Jesus sent two of them on ahead. ² "Go into the village over there," He said. "As soon as you enter it, you will see a donkey tied there, with its colt beside it. Untie them and bring them to Me. ³ If anyone asks what you are doing, just say, 'The Lord needs them,' and he will immediately let you take them."

⁴This took place to fulfill the prophecy that said,

⁵ "Tell the people of Jerusalem, 'Look, your King is coming to you. He is humble, riding on a donkey riding on a donkey's colt.'" (Zechariah 9:9)

⁶The two disciples did as Jesus commanded. ⁷They brought the donkey and the colt to Him and threw their garments over the colt, and He sat on it.

⁸ Most of the crowd spread their garments on the road ahead of Him, and others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road. ⁹ Jesus was in the center of the procession, and the people all around Him were shouting,

"Praise God for the Son of David! (Psalm 118:26)

Blessings on the one who comes in the name of the LORD!

Praise God in highest heaven!"

¹⁰ The entire city of Jerusalem was in an uproar as He entered. "Who is this?" they asked.

¹¹And the crowds replied, "It's Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth in Galilee."

•	Angaria - A Roman and Persian tradition that involved servants requesting livestock or other items from the public to be used by major politica figures/royalty for service.
